Last month I mentioned the number of Snobirds family members that had passed away in such a short time. Well, there's one more to add to the list, Joe Mingari passed away on September 19th. Joe and Judy were lifetime members of the club, starting their 43rd year as members. I'm sure we'll all miss Joe, and offer our sympathies to Judy and family.

We are looking at arranging some sessions with the fire department, two are optional for anyone who is interested. First, we are looking at a short first aid demo that would take place at a meeting. I'm sure we will all gain some practical information from this. Second, if anyone is interested in taking a full first aid course, that might be available. There would be a cost for the first aid book and materials, roughly \$22, and you would receive a two-year certification. And last, we may be involved in an accident simulation. Probably as the victims, for those willing, as a training exercise for the department. Plans are still in progress, we are looking at a January timeframe.

We are all looking forward to the annual Christmas party - the arrangements are in place with a few final details remaining. The location is the same as last year, everyone seemed pleased with what took place then. Be sure to make reservations!

The paving of the Bugline sections seems fairly certain, despite any objections... who cares what the voters think anyway, right? It's largely federal money. There are still some meetings scheduled, but they seem mostly patronizing and probably won't change the results.

## SAFETY SCHOOL

The Snobirds will again be offering snowmobile safety classes this winter. The classes are conducted by qualified instructors, from the Snobirds, who are certified by the State D.N.R.. Satisfactory completion of the class meets the D.N.R. requirements.

“Any person who is at least 12 years old AND who is born on or after January 1, 1985 is required to possess a *valid Snowmobile Safety Certificate* in order to operate a snowmobile on public trails, lands or frozen waters. You must carry the certificate while riding and you must display it to a law enforcement officer when requested.”

As this training is important to public and personal safety, a parent or guardian is welcome to attend with their student without paying a fee, unless they also wish to be certified. There is a \$10 fee for registration and D.N.R. safety materials. The course consists of three evening classes with subjects of snowmobile laws, ethics, terminology, maintenance, clothing, first aid, environmental and ecology problems.

We have two sets of indoor sessions scheduled this season. Total cost is \$10.00

The first set will be December 5, 12 and 19 at the Menomonee Falls Community Center, W152 N8645 Margaret Rd in Menomonee Falls.

The second set of classes will be on January 9, 16 and 23.

For reservations call Gary Breuckman at 414-442-4279. Classes run from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. each night, and you must attend all three sessions to be certified.
